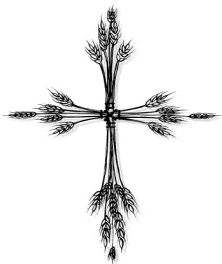

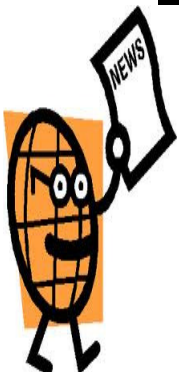

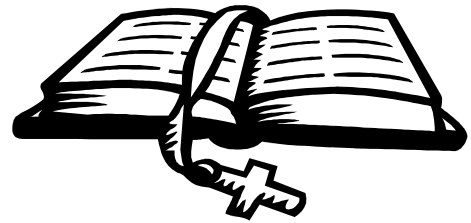

## ON SUMMER HIATUS

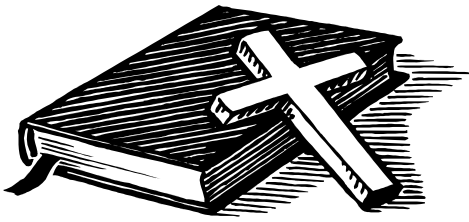

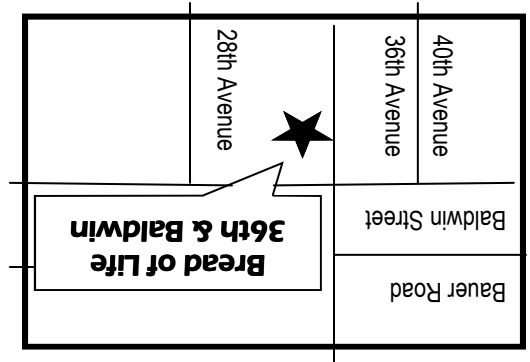
