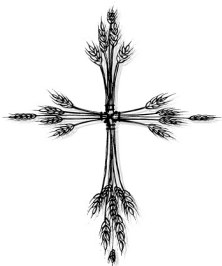

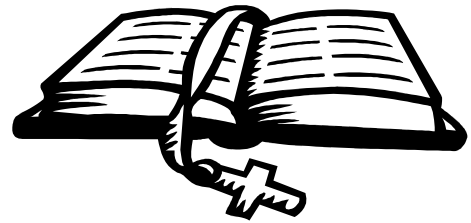

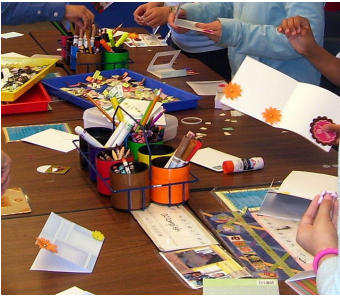

An 80-acre Reminder of Life's Simple Pleasures

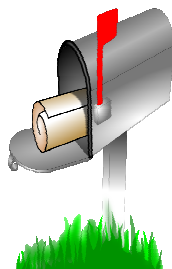


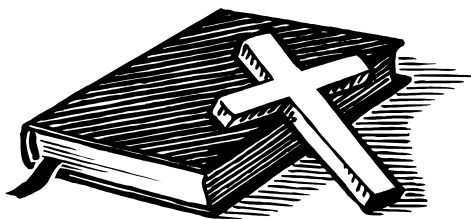

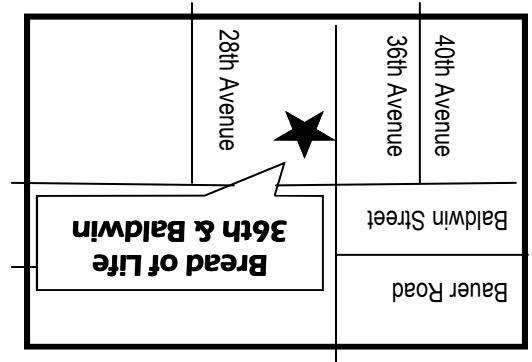
