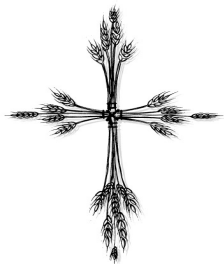

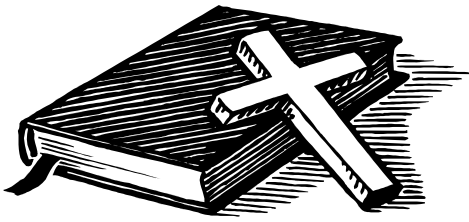
Monthly Card Making Ministry

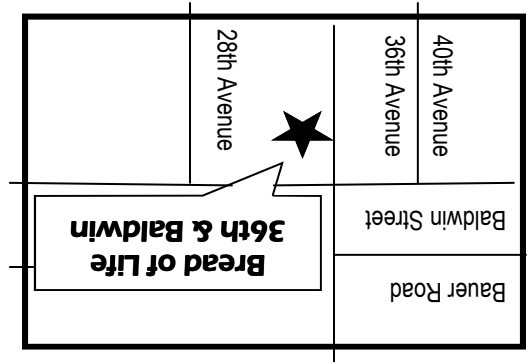
