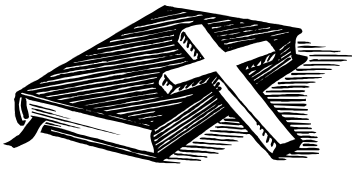
## **Monthly Card Making Ministry**

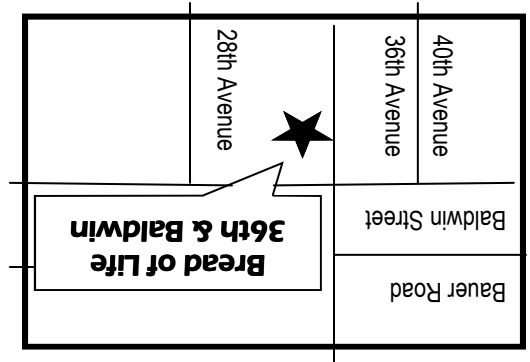
