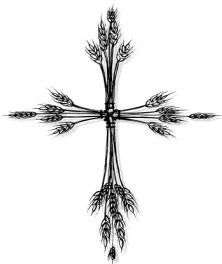

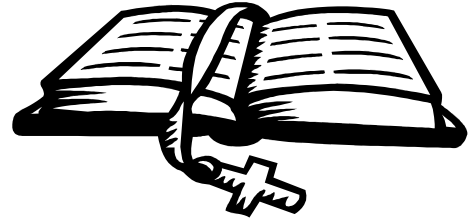

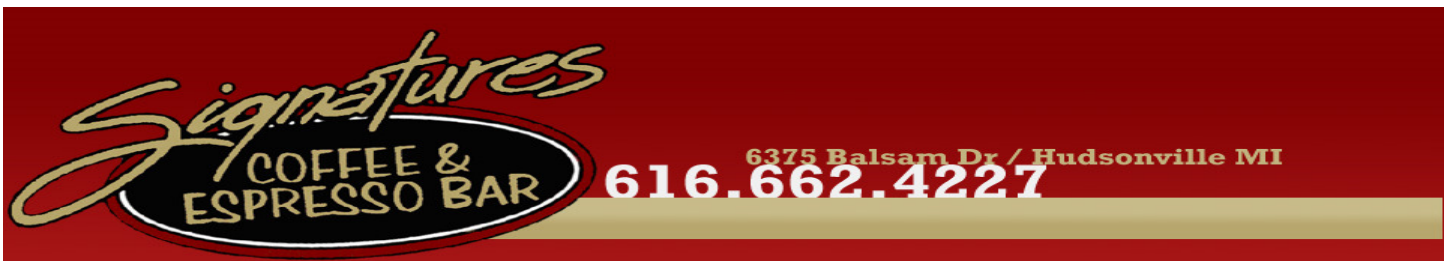
HELP WANTED!!

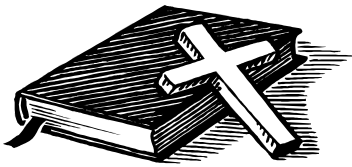

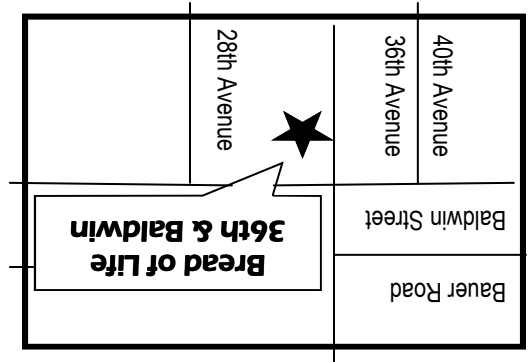
