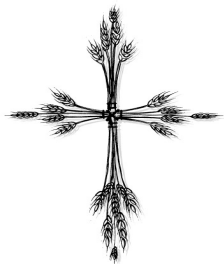

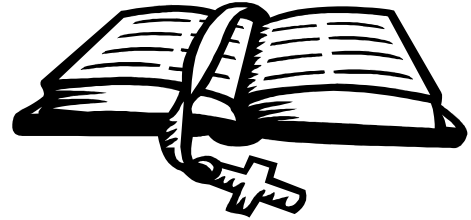

Hudsonville Meijer customers are encouraged to purchase a Simply Give donation card (\$10) upon checkout.

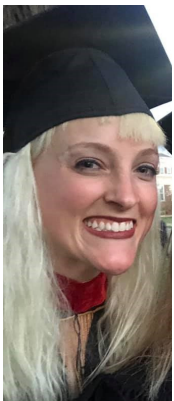
The donation card is then converted into a Meijer Food-Only Gift Card.

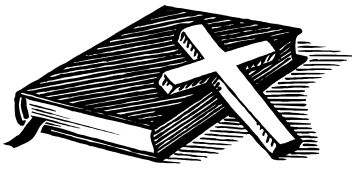

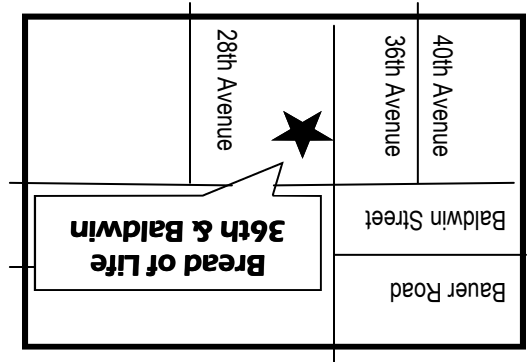
